For fully describing case(s) and literature review, the manuscript word count should be more than 2500.

\*1 Title

\*2 Author(s)

# \*3 Abstract (one paragraph, unstructured, up to 350 words)

The patient's main concerns and important clinical findings; The primary diagnoses, interventions, and outcomes; What is unique about this case and what does it add to the scientific literature; One or more learning points from this case report.

# \*4 Keywords (up to 10)

## \*5 Introduction

Briefly summarizes the background of this disease, and why this case is unique and may include medical literature references.

## \*6 Case Report

This section **should** include **4** subheadings:

## \*1) Investigations (patient information and clinical findings)

De-identified patient specific information; Primary concerns and symptoms of the patient; Medical, family, and psychosocial history including relevant genetic information; Relevant past interventions and their outcomes; Significant physical examination (PE) and important clinical findings. A Timeline is preferable: Historical and current information from this episode of care organized as a timeline (figure or table).



# \*<u>2) Diagnosis</u>

Diagnostic methods (PE, laboratory testing, imaging, surveys); Diagnostic challenges; Diagnosis (including other diagnoses considered); Differential diagnosis if applicable; Prognostic characteristics when applicable.

## \*<u>3) Treatment</u>

Types of therapeutic intervention (pharmacologic, surgical, preventive); Administration of therapeutic intervention (dosage, strength, duration); Changes in therapeutic interventions with explanations.

### \*<u>4) Follow-up and outcomes</u>

Clinician- and patient-assessed outcomes if available; Important follow-up diagnostic and other test results; Intervention adherence and tolerability, (How was this assessed?); Adverse and unanticipated events.

#### \*7 Discussion

Strengths and limitations in your approach to this case; Discussion of the relevant medical literature; The rationale for your conclusions.

\*With a subheading of **Learning Points**, the primary "take-away" lessons (learning points) from this case report (without references) in one paragraph.
